

Singapore Sake Challenge 2024 Application Rules

TOPIC	POINT
Eligibility Criteria	All producers, distributors, exporters, consultants and importers of sake.
Types of Sake	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sake made by all methods and types (Honjozo, Junmai, Ginjo, Junmai Ginjo, Daiginjo, Junmai Daiginjo, Koshu, Umeshu, Yuzushu, Wine produced in Japan, etc.). Alcohol percentage must be less than 20%.
Sizes of Sake	Standard 2 x 720ml bottles for each entry. -A total amount of 1440ml entered as minimum, ex. 5x 300ml bottles. Each bottle must be less than 1L.
How to Enter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Via official website *Alternatively, please use the Registration Form
Entry Fee	¥57,000 per entry *Any separately incurred expenses such as shipping and insurance costs for sending the entry sake are to be covered by the applicant. *Local organisers are responsible for the expenses related to import operations, customs duties and other related costs.

Step1

- Entry via official website or by sending the registration form (from website)

- If you do not receive the email, please let us know.

Step3

- Please send sample bottles of entry sake to the local organiser in Singapore.
- Note1: Please send sample bottles as indicated in the email sent to the applicant with the information on sending the sample bottles of entry sake.
- Note2: Please attach the information label on the back of each sample bottle.

Step4

- We will handle your sample bottles carefully.
- Please wait until the results are announced.
